Independent Contractor Agreement

Your services as an Independent Contractor for the National Umpires Association (NUA) are appreciated for a period of one (1) year. You must sign a new Independent Contractor Agreement each year that you umpire for NUA. You are not an employee of NUA or any institution for which we provide services. You will be provided compensation/expenses for your services based on information provided by NUA. Fees paid to umpires over six hundred dollars (\$600) in compensation will be reported to the Internal Revenue Service, Form 1099M. As an independent contractor, you are not an employee and are not eligible for unemployment insurance benefits. Under no circumstances will umpires be paid for any travel, rainout games, or for extra time spent between games because of rain delays. NUA Umpires will only be paid for games they work.

Independent contractors of NUA are covered under a "secondary" policy and premium up to \$25,000 in medical expense insurance in the event you are injured only while performing duties on the field. There is a \$100 deductible for medical expenses under this secondary policy. This policy does not cover any type of injury during travel to and from games and no other insurance is provided for any injuries off the field. NUA Umpires will only be covered for injuries that take place on the field. NUA, its umpires and board members, shall not, in any manner, be construed or considered as employees of NUA. Instead, it is specifically agreed that NUA umpires and board members will act as independent contractors of NUA and acquire no rights to workers compensation benefits, unemployment compensation benefits, medical and hospital benefits unless injured on the field, sick and vacation leave, severance pay, pension benefits or other rights.

Under no circumstances nor for any reason will an umpire's registration fee be refunded.
